

## Are you turning 26?

## Learn about your Health Insurance options with HealthSource RI

HealthSource RI connects you with brand-name health insurance companies, giving you a whole new way to buy coverage and get the essential health benefits you need. If you are losing health coverage because you no longer qualify as a dependent on your parents' insurance once you turn 26, you may be eligible right away for low-cost insurance or free Medicaid coverage through HealthSource RI.

HealthSource RI offers a "Special Enrollment Period" (SEP) to people going through life changes such as:

- You're too old to be covered by your parents.

  If you've been covered on your parents' policy, but have turned 26 years old, you're eligible to enroll in your own coverage.
- Your employer changes the coverage available to you.

  If your employer discontinues your health insurance or changes the coverage offered and you're allowed to terminate that plan, you may be eligible to enroll in a new plan during a SEP.
- You've lost your health insurance through a job or graduation.

  If you leave a job or higher education institution where you were provided health insurance, or have been let go from a job where you received health insurance, you can enroll through HealthSource RI.
- ♦ Your immigration status has changed.

  You must be a U.S. citizen or be lawfully present in the U.S. to buy insurance through HealthSource RI.
- You have a new spouse.

  A new marriage means you don't have to wait to cover your husband or wife, or wait to be covered.
- You got divorced.
  Losing your spouse doesn't mean losing coverage.
- You're an AmeriCorps, VISTA or NCCC volunteer.
   You may qualify for a SEP when your volunteer program begins or ends.
- You're new to Rhode Island.

  If you've just moved here from out of state and don't have access to health insurance through an employer, you can enroll through HealthSource RI.
