# PATHWAYS TO HEALTH COVERAGE IN RHODE ISLAND?

Looking for health coverage in RI? See if you fit into one of the below scenarios. **6 out of 7** applicants through HealthSource RI qualify for financial assistance.

## I don't have coverage through a job.

While many full-time jobs offer coverage for employees and their families, your hours or position may not qualify for employer-sponsored insurance. [HealthSource RI](#) may be able to help.

*Employer-sponsored insurance doesn't affordably cover what you need?*

You and/or your family may qualify for a plan through [HealthSource RI](#) with financial assistance.

*Lost coverage through your employer?*

You and/or any formerly covered family members may be eligible for coverage through [HealthSource RI](#).



## I am going through a life change that affects my coverage.

You may be eligible for coverage through [HealthSource RI's special enrollment period](#).

## I am a student.

You may be eligible for a Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) and/or coverage through [HealthSource RI](#). International students may be eligible too.

## I am retired or retiring.

*Under 65?*

You may qualify for coverage through [HealthSource RI](#).

*Over 65?*

You may qualify for [Medicare coverage](#) or coverage through [HealthSource RI](#).

## My immigration status is undocumented.

*Pregnant?*

You may be eligible for [Medicaid](#) during pregnancy and up to 12 months postpartum.

*Under 19?*

Get covered with [Medicaid's Cover All Kids](#) program.

*DACA recipient?*

If you have DACA status beginning November 1st, 2024, you may apply for coverage through [HealthSource RI](#).

*19 and over without DACA status?*

You are likely unable to get covered through HealthSource RI or Medicaid at this time. However, there are certain protections for both treatment and privacy guaranteed to all people regardless of immigration status. To learn more, we suggest visiting the [RI Immigrant Coalition](#) website.



## I am a lawfully present immigrant.

You may be eligible for coverage through [HealthSource RI](#) or [Medicaid](#).

## I'm worried I can't afford health insurance.

You may qualify for coverage and financial assistance through [HealthSource RI](#). You may also qualify for no-cost coverage through [Medicaid](#).

## I have a disability.

You may qualify for coverage through [HealthSource RI](#) or [Medicaid](#).

*Under 19?* You may qualify for [Katie Beckett Medicaid](#).

*Over 19?*

You may qualify for [Elders and Adults with Disabilities \(EAD\) Medicaid](#).

*Disabled and working?*

You may qualify for [Sherlock Medicaid](#).

## None of these scenarios describe my situation, or my situation is too complex.
